

Will Wording

We are deeply grateful that you are considering creating your legacy with the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan to help support cancer care for patients across our province.

Here is valuable information to share with your lawyer or professional advisor as they guide you through this process.

Most people opt to make one of two types of gifts - residual or specific.

A residual gift allows you to give a share or a percentage of whatever is leftover in your estate to charity. You may prefer this option if you are unsure of the total size of your estate or interested in dividing up your total assets among your beneficiaries.

Sample wording for a residual gift:

"I direct my Trustee to pay and transfer a _____% share of the rest and residue of my estate to the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc. (charitable registration #719679920RR0001) for their general use and utilization".

With a specific gift, you set a dollar amount to donate. You may prefer this choice if you know the impact you want to make and the size of the gift that works for you.

Sample wording for specific gift:

"I direct my Trustee to pay the sum of \$_____ dollars to the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc. (charitable registration #719679920RR0001) for their general use and utilization".

Power to Vary Clause

Power to Vary Clause (please include if your bequest is restricted): "In the event that unforeseen circumstances make the specified use of this bequest no longer practical, the Foundation Board is hereby authorized to make such changes that are in keeping as far as possible with the direction and general intent of this bequest."
